## GENERAL RULES

**It is the responsibility of the teacher, parents, and students  
to read and follow these rules.**

### Working Management:

1. The competitions shall be under the working management of the Festival Organizing Committee, and the Syllabus and Program Committees, all of which is hereinafter called "The Committee". Any questions not dealt with in these rules shall be referred to the Committee, whose decisions on such matters shall be final and binding on all concerned.

### Eligibility-Definitions

2. All competitions, unless otherwise stated, shall be open to amateurs only. For the purpose of these competitions, an amateur shall be defined as follows: *An Amateur is a music student or any person whose principal means of livelihood is not and never was obtained from the performance or teaching of music, even though from time to time such persons are in receipt of remunerations for musical services rendered. Music students who teach for the purpose of applying the money so earned to the furtherance of their musical education will be classed as amateurs.*
3. Where age limits are specified, competitors must be of the prescribed age on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January in the year of the Festival to be entered. Competitors must state on the entry form the level of music they are presently studying. STUDENTS MUST ENTER ALL CLASSES WITHIN A DISCIPLINE AT THE SAME LEVEL. In the case of Vocal, students must be at the same grade or age level. **(NOTE: Musical Theatre Classes and Vocal Classes comprise two separate disciplines.)**
4. Competitors must not use a selection with which they have previously won a first standing.
5. A competitor may perform only once in a class.

### Test Pieces

6. Test pieces must be chosen only from the following syllabi:  
Piano - RCM 2022, CC 1999 revised edition, CC 2018 Classical Piano Syllabus, Contemporary Showcase Syllabus  
Voice - RCM 2019, Conservatory Canada 2018 Classical Voice syllabus  
Strings - RCM Cello 2021, RCM Violin 2021, CC Violin 2001  
Entry forms MUST indicate correct page numbers from the current RCM, CC or CCS Syllabus.
7. Competitors in all classes must furnish a purchased score of the test piece for the use of the adjudicator. No music scores are supplied by the adjudicator except for Sight Reading classes. The purchased score must be presented to the Desk Secretary immediately preceding the respective competition and claimed immediately after the class.
8. Photocopied material is allowed only for the accompanist as long as a purchased score is also present for the adjudicator. Proof of purchase must be presented for music downloaded from the internet for any score used. If a copyright has not been respected by the performer, the performer will be eligible for adjudication only.
9. OWN CHOICE CLASSES: A test piece may not be used in more than one class. The title, timing, and composer must be specified on the entry form. The suitability of the selection for the age and level of the competitor will be considered by the adjudicator in the evaluation of the performance.

## Entries

10. The entry fee will not, under any circumstances, be refunded.
11. In the event that entries in any specific discipline are insufficient to warrant hiring a special adjudicator, the Committee reserves the right to cancel classes and refund entry fee
12. **Requests for additional classes may be submitted** and will be considered by the Festival Committee. The deadline to add classes is January 01, 2024.

## Program Procedure

13. The Committee reserves the right to split any classes into two or three groups of approximately equal numbers. Certificates will be issued for each group as a separate class.
14. An e-mail will be forwarded to each teacher informing them of the time, date, and location of each class entered.
15. Scheduling conflicts within the Festival performance schedule must be identified by March 1, 2024. All requests for scheduling changes must be received in writing. Changes made after this date will result in adjudication only (email [ckmf@chathamkiwanis.com](mailto:ckmf@chathamkiwanis.com))
16. The Committee reserves the right to disqualify any competitor who is not ready to compete within five minutes of being called.
17. If competitors do not perform the test piece as entered on their entry form, or if they perform a selection that does not meet the class description, they will receive adjudication only, and no mark.
18. Memorization: Solo performers must memorize selections as instructed in Conservatory Syllabi. Bands, String Ensembles and other instrumental classes need not memorize. Solo performers who refer to music during the performance of a test piece which should be memorized will not be eligible for first place.
17. The Festival auditorium or Festival instruments must not be used other than for competition.
18. Competitors requiring music stands must supply their own.
19. In order to ensure impartiality, at no time should any competitor, parent, or teacher approach the adjudicator. Necessary questions from a competitor must be directed to the Desk Secretary. Breaches of this rule may result in the competitor's disqualification.
20. Coaching during performance from teachers, parents, or others in the audience is prohibited and may result in the competitor's disqualification.
21. No flash photography is permitted during performances or adjudication.

## Rules and Regulations Specific to Awards

22. A minimum standing of 80, 75, and 70 must be obtained for first, second or third class awards respectively. Trophies, plaques and cash awards are given to competitors who, in the opinion of the adjudicators, show the most promise of future development musically and are **not necessarily** awarded to the winners of first, second or third place. To be eligible for an award, plaque or trophy, a competitor must have competed in two Solo classes of the same discipline and obtained a minimum mark of 80 in each class. Studies and Sight Reading classes are not eligible for cash award consideration. See specific rules for each discipline.
23. Award cheques are VOID after 30 days.

24. Adjudicators will not “tie” for first place.
25. All shields, plaques and trophies are the property of the Music Festival and unless otherwise stipulated, shall be held by the winner until February 15<sup>th</sup> of the following year, and then returned to the Kiwanis Club of Chatham-Kent.

#### **Final Concert**

26. A group of contestants recommended by the adjudicators will be called upon to perform at the Grand Concert.
27. The Golden K Kiwanis Bowl, the Silver Tray, and Kiwanis Bowl will be presented at the Grand Concert. The winners must be available to perform at the concert, **Monday April 29, 2024.**

#### **Concerns and Suggestions**

28. Concerns or suggestions must be made in writing (hardcopy, not e-mail) to the Resolution Committee through the Festival Chairpersons.
29. The adjudicator’s decision is final in issues related to adjudicator decisions.

#### **Ontario Provincial Festival Information**

30. Up to two students, from each level from each discipline may be recommended by the adjudicators to compete in the Ontario Provincial Festival.
31. To receive an adjudicator’s recommendation, a minimum mark of 85 must be achieved. The potential of the student to benefit from the experience is also a consideration. The Chatham Kiwanis Music Festival prefers that the student has entered more than one class in the discipline to receive a recommendation, however this is not a rule of the Ontario Provincial Festival.
32. While it is an honour to receive a recommendation to the Ontario Provincial Festival, it is not to be perceived as an award from the Chatham Kiwanis Music Festival. For more information, visit [www.omfa.ca](http://www.omfa.ca).
33. In deciding the level, a competitor must not have passed Conservatory Examinations at that level or higher before Dec 31<sup>st</sup>. Competitors who enter this festival performing more than two selections above their listed level will be considered as working at that higher level, and therefore must compete in all classes at the higher level.

However, if accompanists have overbooked, conflicts will occur and changes will not be made.

## Vocal

### Linda Fletcher



Linda Fletcher, of Oakville, is very active in the music community as a teacher, composer, singer, adjudicator, clinician, accompanist, and music director.

She began her piano studies with Grace Vandendool and went on to graduate Magna Cum Laude with a Bachelor of Music (honours) degree in Music Education from McMaster University, where she studied piano with Reginald Bedford, and voice with Dr. Gladys Whitehead. She received her Bachelor of Education from the Ontario Teacher Education College and her A. Mus. degree in voice from the University of Western Ontario, for which she was awarded the gold medal for the highest mark in Canada. Linda continued her study of voice with Tom Oliver and organ with Keith Hopkins. She also plays French horn and guitar.

Linda is a composer of choral and vocal solo music and writes both secular and sacred music. Her first published choral composition, *A Song of Sharing*, became the publisher's best-selling song with international sales of over 15,000 copies and has since gained more popularity as a festival and exam selection. Another, Linda's setting of *The Olde Irish Blessing* was performed in Rome for World Youth Day before an audience of 3,000 and continues to be performed worldwide. She was the compiler and editor of a series of Canadian song books entitled *Sing!* published by Leslie Music Supply. Since 2021 Linda has been part of the Full Voice team and some of her newest songs and her most recent book "Children's Songs of Praise" are distributed in partnership with Full Voice Music Inc.

Linda was a member of the creative team for the 2012 Royal Conservatory of Music (RCM) voice series and worked as a compiler and editor for their 2019 voice syllabus. Fifteen of her songs are included in the latest voice syllabus with five of those appearing in the voice repertoire books. In 2019, Linda was invited to be a presenter for the RCM "Artistry and Innovation" Summit.

Linda was co-writer, performer and arranger, with director Tom Oliver, for *Voices in the Night*, a non-profit fundraising vehicle, created by Linda and Mr. Oliver in 1996, which travelled throughout Southern Ontario for over 10 years. Linda also acted as singer and chorus director for two Juno-nominated recordings of children's entertainer, Eric Nagler.

Linda is a member of ACTRA, NATS, SOCAN, ACWC and ORMTA, where she served on the executive for ten years and was a workshop clinician for their 2012 ORMTA Provincial Convention.

Linda continues to reside in Oakville with her husband, John. They are blessed with four children who also share Linda's love of music, and five grandchildren.

Described as a “thoughtful and immensely exciting performer” with “scintillating technique” (Barrie Examiner) and “intelligently rounded musicianship” (The Irish Times), pianist Benjamin Smith has performed as soloist and chamber musician across Canada and the United States. He has been a laureate of numerous competitions, including the Dublin International Piano Competition, the Virginia Waring International Piano Competition, and the CMC Stepping Stone Competition. Guest appearances include the Stony Brook Symphony Orchestra, the New Juilliard Ensemble, the Las Vegas Young Artists Orchestra, the Ontario Philharmonic, Orchestra London, the Burlington Symphony, and the University of Toronto’s Hart House Orchestra. As soloist, he has performed under esteemed conductors Rossen Milanov, Timothy Vernon, Marco Parisotto, and Yunion Lopez, with concertos including uncommon rarities such as the Schoenberg Piano Concerto. Festival performances include repeat appearances at Toronto, Stratford, Niagara, and New Park (Ithaca, NY). American performances include recitals for the Texas

Chopin Society and Chicago’s Landowska Harpsichord Society. Recent seasons have seen two concerts in Carnegie Hall: once as soloist in Gershwin’s Rhapsody In Blue with the Hart House Orchestra, and previously in recital with Canadian cellist Dongkyun An. A disc with Mr. An of Saint-Saens, Schumann, and Beethoven was released in December 2016.

Devoting considerable time to chamber music, Ben has been heard nationally across Canada on CBC Music, as well as radio broadcasts in the UK. He has partnered in recital with a myriad of renowned artists including Martin Beaver, Timothy Chooi, Colin Carr, Narek Hakhnazaryan, Stanislav Pronin, Jacques Israelievitch, Jinjoo Cho, Gábor Tarkövi, Øystein Baadsvik, and William VerMeulen, as well as with ensembles such as the Penderecki, Cecilia, Annex, and Tokai string quartets. For two seasons he performed as one-third of the Israelievitch-Smith-Ahn piano trio, and has recently been playing as a member of the Andromeda piano trio.

Dr. Smith currently resides in Toronto, maintaining a concert schedule and serving on the faculties of both the Glenn Gould School (GGS) and the Taylor Young Artist Academy at the Royal Conservatory. Previously, he held a position on the piano faculty at Western University. His principal teachers included Andrea Battista, James Anagnoson, Julian Martin, and Christina Dahl. Along with a DMA from Stony Brook University, he holds a Bachelors degree from the University of Toronto, an Artist Diploma from the GGS, and a Masters from Juilliard.
